**COUNTY YOUTH BUREAU ANNOUNCES NEW
EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAM FOR YOUTH**

Eligible youth must submit applications by Feb. 15th

New City, NY – The Rockland County Youth Bureau announces a new workforce preparation and placement program called T.E.E.N. (Teen Employment Education Network) Works.

This new 20-week program is designed to provide youth between the ages of 14 and 21, who meet eligibility requirements, with a meaningful experience in the workforce. The program will offer training, experiential activities and paid job placement upon successful completion of the program. Funded by the County of Rockland, the goal of the program is to train teens and young adults to become successful, contributing members of the workforce with strong goals for the future. Participants will receive four stipends of \$125 each over the 20 weeks and possible job placement at the end of the program.

Applications for T.E.E.N. Works are currently available and can be mailed, e-mailed or picked up from the Youth Bureau. The **deadline for submitting an application is Wednesday, February 15, 2012.** The program will run from March 12 and conclude on August 21, 2012.
